AGENDA ITEM: **KHA Reimbursement from Kansas Bred Program**

PRESENTER: Neysa Thomas, Chief Fiscal Officer

ISSUE SUMMARY: The Kansas Horsemen's Association (KHA) is requesting reimbursement of \$2,144.21 for expenses incurred for the operation of the Kansas Bred Program in August 2008. The expenses presented for reimbursement are consistent with expenses incurred by the KHA in the past.

The Kansas Horsemen's Association's request is subject to availability of funds and the KHA is aware that funds are currently not available to cover all expenses for August 2008. The account balance as of 10-31-08 is \$539.47.

The Commission is authorized by K.S.A. 74-8830 to "contract with and designate an official registering agency to implement the registration of horses." The Commission's contract with the KHA provides that funds shall be withdrawn from the Kansas Bred Program account only for maintaining and administering the program in accordance with the agreement and only with the prior approval of the Commission or the Commission's executive director.

COMMISSION ACTION REQUIRED/REQUESTED: Commission discussion, consideration and possible action on the request for reimbursement.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS: Staff recommends approval of the expenses and a partial reimbursement in the amount of \$500.00. The KHA may request the balance of August 2008 operating expenses when funds become available.

Re: Compliance Audit of Kansas Horsemen's Association

We have performed a compliance audit of the Kansas Horsemen's Association ("KHA") operations for the year ended December 31, 2007. This compliance audit is substantially less in scope than an audit of financial statements in accordance with Statement on Auditing Standards as promulgated by the Auditing Standards Board of the AICPA. KRGC is not independent with respect to the KHA.

The KHA contracts with the KRGC to serve as the official horse registering agency for Kansas, in accordance with K.S.A. 74-8830.

We have attached the Balance Sheet of the KHA at December 31, 2007 and the related Profit & Loss Statement for the KHA for the year ended December 31, 2007.

Balance Sheet

The Balance Sheet reflects an increase of cash and equity during the year ended December 31, 2007. The cause for the increase in cash and equity results principally from the net income for the year.

Office equipment with acquisition costs of \$2,494 is fully depreciated.

Liabilities shown relate to payroll taxes payable by the Association at the end of 2007.

Profit & Loss Statement

The KHA had net income in 2007 of \$10,287. In 2006, the Association had a loss of \$2,700.

Findings

We noted a significant lack of segregation of duties because the Association's bookkeeper is the only employee of KHA and, consequently, she performs virtually all the recordkeeping and reconciliation processes that underlie the financial and other data we audited. This is typical in an organization of this size and is usually mitigated by oversight performed by others in a position to review her work. Some review is performed and adjustments made during the annual tax preparation but daily work is typically not reviewed.

We noted no issues of non-compliance by the KHA, with the rules and regulations of the KRGC, that would require disclosure to the Commission in this report.

AGENDA ITEM: **Non-approval of the Lottery Gaming Facility Review Board's recommendation of Sumner Gaming Joint Venture, LLC (d/b/a Harrah's Kansas).**

PRESENTER: Patrick D. Martin, Assistant Attorney General

ISSUE SUMMARY: On August 22, 2008, the Lottery Gaming Facility Review Board selected Sumner Gaming Joint Venture, LLC (d/b/a Harrah's Kansas) as the manager of a gaming facility in the south central gaming zone. The Review Board then forwarded that recommendation on to the KRGC. Since that recommendation, Sumner Gaming Joint Venture, LLC has voluntarily withdrawn from consideration as a lottery gaming facility manager. Without another applicant in that gaming zone, the state would like to restart the selection process.

To aid in restarting that process, the KRGC should formally "not approve" the Review Board's recommendation. That action is called for under the express language of the Kansas Expanded Lottery Act. Specifically, KELA provides that the process for selection of a lottery gaming facility manager "shall begin again" if the KRGC "does not approve the recommendation of the lottery gaming facility review board." K.S.A. 74- 8736(e). In full, that provision of KELA states:

Upon completion of such investigations and approval of the background of the prospective lottery gaming facility manager . . . but not more than 10 days after receiving the recommendation of the lottery gaming facility review board, the Kansas racing and gaming commission shall vote to approve in whole or reject in whole the recommendation of the lottery gaming facility review board. If the Kansas racing and gaming commission does not approve the background of such prospective lottery gaming facility manager, directors, officers and other persons having an interest in such prospective manager *or does not approve the recommendation of the lottery gaming facility review board, the Kansas racing and gaming commission shall notify the executive director of the lottery and the process for selection of a lottery gaming facility manager shall begin again* in the manner provided in sections 3 and 4, and amendments thereto.

Id. (emphasis added).

Both the KRGC counsel and the Lottery are in agreement that, under KELA's language, the KRGC should formally "not approve the recommendation of the lottery gaming facility review board" to begin the selection process in the south central zone again.

COMMISSION ACTION REQUIRED/REQUESTED

Staff suggests the following motion:

“In light of Sumner Gaming Joint Venture, LLC’s voluntary withdrawal from the south central gaming zone, the KRGC does not approve the August 22, 2008, recommendation of the Lottery Gaming Facility Review Board. The KRGC makes this final decision so that the Kansas Lottery may restart the application process in the south central zone. To be clear, this is not a decision on Sumner Gaming Joint Venture, LLC’s background.”

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS: Staff recommends adopting the motion not approving the Review Board’s recommendation for the south central gaming zone.
