

The Kansas Lottery Gaming Facility Review Board is appointed as follows:

Three members are appointed by the governor.¹

Two members are appointed by the president of the senate.²

Two members are appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.³

No more than four members of the board may be members of the same political party, and no board member is eligible to be a board member if they are a resident of or own property in a gaming zone, has an interest in any business domiciled in or conducting a significant portion of its business in a gaming zone or has, or has had during the preceding two years, either directly or indirectly, a financial interest in or is, or has been during the preceding two years, employed by or a consultant to a prospective lottery gaming facility manager or any ancillary lottery gaming facility operations proposed by a prospective lottery gaming facility manager.⁴

The appointments to the Lottery Gaming Facility Board are as follows:

Governor Kathleen Sebelius appointed James Bergfalk, Dr. Jacqueline Vietti and Matt All. Matt All was appointed chairman by the governor.

Senate President Stephen Morris appointed Bob Boaldin and Dean Ferrell.

Speaker of the House Melvin Neufeld appointed Jack Brier and Garry Boston.
