(A.) Chairman Jay Shadwick called the May 17, 2013, meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. at 700 SW Harrison, Auditorium B, Suite 460, Topeka, Kansas. In addition to Chairman Shadwick, Commissioners Timothy Shultz, R. Eileen King and David H. Moses were present at the meeting. Commissioner Dennis McKinney was absent. Others present included Executive Director Richard Petersen-Klein, Director of Security Don Brownlee, Interim Director of Administration and Finance Brandi White, General Counsel Judith Taylor, Interim Director of IT and Electronic Security Dennis Bachman, recording secretary Chris Vega and other staff.

(E.1.) Sharon Stroburg, General Manager, reported that:
- For the month of April 2013, BHCR increased revenue over April 2012 by just over 3%. This was due to an increase in marketing promotional activity.

(E.2.) Wendy Runde, Assistant General Manager, reported that:
- April 2013 admissions per day were down 2.5% from March 2013.
 - April revenue numbers:
 - Total gaming revenue down 10.9% from March 2013.
 - Slot coin-in (Handle) down 13.6% from March 2013.
 - Slot win down 8% from March 2013. April hold up .02% from March 2013.
 - Table game drop down 13.6% from March 2013.
 - Table game win down 2.5% from March. Hold 21.0% vs. 18.6% in March.
 - Poker room revenue daily average down 4% from March 2013.

- Construction work on the Arena conversion is on schedule.

Dean Doria, Vice President of Marketing, reported that:

- April 2013 gaming revenues were strong and showed a nice increase over April of 2012.
- Total gaming revenue was \$11.0 million for April 2013 which was \$1.7 million or 18% greater than April 2012.
- Table games revenue was \$1.7 million, which was \$190,000 or 10% less than prior year.
- Slot revenue was \$9.3 million, an increase of \$1.9 million or 25% over the prior year.
- The STP 400 NASCAR Sprint Cup race, as well as the Camping World Truck Series race, took place over the weekend of April 19th. These events were well attended as were a number of events surrounding the race activities. Traffic concerns were minimal.
- Other promotions throughout the month included a \$20,000 prize drawing, and a Tax Day Giveaway. Both drew nice attendance as did the other regular monthly promotional programming in slots, poker and food and beverage.

Gaming revenues continued the trend in exceeding prior year as we had a significant increase over May of 2012.

Total Gaming Revenue was \$11.4 MM for May 2013 which was \$1.7 MM, or 17%, greater than May 2012.

Table Games Revenue was \$1.7 MM, which was flat with prior year.

Slot Revenue was \$9.7 MM which was an increase of \$1.7MM, or 21%, over the prior year.

In May we kicked off our Sizzling Summer Giveaway during which players earn entries into drawings for prizes totaling \$30,000 in value. That is coupled with our other weekly promotions held throughout the month to include our Superstar Reels daily promotion. We had a NASCAR watch party for the Talledega 500 with prize giveaways in our Turn 2 sports lounge and restaurant, as well as two Kansas City Royals watch parties during May which included appearances from former Royals alumni. Business over the Memorial Day Weekend wasn't notable and relatively flat compared with typical weekends.
