Sharon Stroburg, General Manager, reported:

- For the month of April 2014, Boot Hill Casino and Resort (BHCR) experienced a decrease in total gaming revenue of 5.84 percent over prior year. Total gaming revenue was down in comparison to previous month as well. This was attributed to both a decrease in slot hold and table games hold over previous month and year.
- A ribbon cutting ceremony will take place Memorial Day weekend for the Buffalo and Longhorn exhibit. Ms. Stroburg handed out an informational packet in regards to the exhibit.
- BHCR is active again with the Dodge City Convention and Visitor's Bureau in which Ms. Stroburg has a seat.
- The bus trips to BHCR are going great and have received

positive feedback from customers. BHCR is going to try nighttime line runs beginning in June.

- Comfort Suites has broken ground in Dodge City.

Daniel Ihm, Assistant General Manager, reported:

- April admissions were down ten percent from April 2013.
- Construction of the Kansas Star Casino convention/meeting space is under way with a projected opening date during the first quarter of 2015.
- Even though half of the space in the arena was used, the Asian concert that was held in the arena on April 19th was a sell-out show with 3,200 to 3,500 in attendance. Due to this event, \$700,000.00 was dropped on table games. Kansas Star is looking to host another one of these events in October or November of this year.
- April revenue numbers compared to April 2013:
 - Total gaming revenue down 12.7 percent.
 - Slot coin-in (handle) down 12.6 percent.
 - Slot hold down 0.3 percent.
 - Table game drop down 6.6 percent.
 - Table game hold up 4.4 percent.
 - Poker room revenue down 12.7 percent.

 - National Roping Championship (June 6th and 7th).

Bob Sheldon, General Manager, reported:

- April revenue numbers compared to April 2013:
 - Total gaming revenue was \$11.2 million, up \$118,000, or 1.1 percent.
 - Table games revenue was \$1.8 million, up 3.3 percent.
 - While volume in table games was marginally ahead of last year, an increase in hold percentage also contributed to year over year gain.
 - Slot revenue was \$9.4 million, up 0.7 percent.
- Along with programmed promotional offers during the month, Hollywood Casino held an invitational slot tournament and also had the grand prize drawing for their

\$25,000 Hidden Treasures Giveaway.

- Attendance was good for their Easter Sunday Special in the Epic Buffet, and also for their Kansas City Royals watch party/meet and greet with John Mayberry in the Turn 2 Sports Bar & Restaurant.

- Mr. Petersen-Klein reported that the Permanent Regulation changes were in the approval process. The temporary regulation changes include K.A.R.'s 112-104-1, 112-104-9 and 112-108-13 related to definitions, comps and gaming chips.
- Clint Patty, the attorney representing BHCR, addressed the commission regarding the addition of 112-104-9(d), that included a specific reference to Internal Revenue Code section 26 USC 274, which addresses the deductibility of complimentary expenses and suggested the reference be eliminated.

STAFF AGENDA MEMORANDUM

AGENDA ITEM: New Business – Education and Experience Qualifications

PRESENTER: Richard Petersen-Klein, Executive Director

ISSUE SUMMARY:

This Commission Item is new business that KRGC staff was asked to provide the Commission for the purpose of determining whether the Commission should establish specific minimum education or experience qualifications for casino positions. Presently, the KRGC's regulations do not specify minimum education or experience qualifications for casino positions. K.S.A. 74-8772 states that the KRGC shall adopt rules and regulations for the determination of qualifications and credentialing of employees of lottery gaming facility managers and ancillary lottery gaming facility operations. Generally, lottery gaming facility managers include minimum education or experience requirements for casino positions in position descriptions or internal controls. The Commission uses those qualifications to determine if a facility manager's officers, key and principal employees, and each applicant for a license satisfy the affirmative duty to demonstrate the qualifications necessary for certification and licensure under KARs 112-101-4, 112-102-6, and 112-103-6. Further, the Commission may deny an applicant a license if the Commission determines the applicant is unqualified to perform the duties required of a position under KAR 112-103-8.

One lottery gaming facility manager is requesting the elimination of all education or experience requirements from all position descriptions or internal controls including the general manager and all other management positions. The KRGC staff suggested that minimum education or experience requirements would be a prudent best practice for supervisory positions at a minimum because those individuals would be expected to know the job functions of positions reporting to that supervisor, so that supervisor would be able to train and monitor performance of direct reports leading to better customer service. Patrons receiving quality customer service would be expected to stay longer and return more frequently resulting in increased gaming revenue for both the State and the lottery gaming facility manager. The response was that KRGC regulations do not specifically require minimum education or experience requirements for casino positions.

Information was gathered from job descriptions and employment advertisements for casino jobs across the United States related to education and experience requirements by job title or position with a focus on supervisory positions. Two reports were prepared – one for the

lottery gaming facility managers and one for all other casino operators outside of Kansas. Each report was sorted by positions in a generic organizational chart beginning with the general manager down to the lowest supervisory position, and grouped by department with gaming departments listed before non-gaming departments. An attempt was made to develop an applicable range or minimum for education and experience for each position based upon the information collected.

Additionally, KRGC staff surveyed statutes and regulations in other jurisdictions for requirements regarding minimum qualification. The statutes and regulations in eleven jurisdictions were examined and only two jurisdictions – Missouri and Pennsylvania – have regulations related to minimum qualification requirements. However, there were no specific minimum requirements enumerated for any position, rather those regulations simply stated that qualifications shall be described for all positions or based upon a licensing level.

The preparation of the final summary reports was still in progress at the time this memorandum was completed. Completion of the final summary reports is expected Monday, June 16, 2014 and will be emailed to each lottery gaming facility manager as well as each Commissioner at that time. KRGC staff does not have specific recommendations for minimum education or experience requirements at this time. Additionally, if the KRGC establishes specific minimum education and experience requirement for each casino position, the KRGC would need to address each existing position and provide specific minimum education and experience requirements for each new casino position. The better approach would appear to be the current practice where each facility manager provides the KRGC with minimum qualifications for each position that are reasonable. However, KRGC staff wanted to ensure that public comment from lottery gaming facility managers regarding the matter begin as soon as possible, and expected the matter to cover multiple meetings.
