John Canham, Interim General Manager, reported:

- June 2015 revenue numbers compared to June 2014:
  - Total gaming revenue was \$11.5 million, an increase of \$1.1 million or 10.2%.
  - Table games revenue was \$1.6 million, an increase of \$202,000.00 or 14.5%. Table volume was slightly behind prior year but hold percentage was significantly higher which accounted for most of the year-over-year increase.
  - Slot revenue was \$9.9 million, an increase of \$860,000.00 or 9.5%.
- Hollywood Casino had the normal complement of monthly promotional offers and restaurant specials.
- The month of June featured the culmination of Hollywood’s first “Spring into Summer” drawing with the grand prize

drawing on June 19th.

## Responsible Gaming Report for January 1 – June 30, 2015

### Employees

During the first half of 2015 KSC processed 168 new team members through new hire orientation. All received the following training courses as part of orientation:

- Responsible Gaming with special emphasis on underage awareness and an overview of the Voluntary Exclusion Program
- Alcohol awareness

An additional and more intensive alcohol awareness program, ServSafe, is given to all team members in Food and Beverage who interact with customers, Table Games and Security. It is a three-hour course with a test at the end which team members must pass with at least a 75% score. In the first half of 2015 133 took this training; 13 failed and will be required to re-take until they pass.

Tiffany Achu in the Food and Beverage Department is our certified ServSafe trainer and administers the classes. Another Food and Beverage manager is in the process of becoming a certified ServSafe trainer.

The property's Responsible Gaming trainers are:

- Rogene Paullo, Human Resources
- Tim Soule, Security
- Meghan Roberts, Human Resources

As of June 30, 2015 KSC had 836 employees.

### Ongoing Training

In addition to the training given in new hire orientation, KSC team members undergo annual refresher training in Responsible Gaming. In 2015 we are initiating our property wide program in the third quarter to coincide with Responsible Gaming Education Week which this year is August 3-7. All team members will receive this training except those who were hired after January 1, 2015. To make training more accessible we also put our Responsible Gaming training module online in our suite of Skillsoft courses.

March 2015 was Problem Gambling Awareness Month and to mark that event and sharpen focus on that issue all KSC team members wore ribbons for the whole month and our management team attended an in-person presentation from Carol Spiker, the problem gambling specialist in the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services on problem gambling and the resources available.

The total amount spent on responsible gaming materials was \$2,221.58 and \$2,731.82 was spent on ServSafe training manuals

Responsible Gaming Education Week, which is August 3-7 falls into the second half of 2015. To highlight this event KSC has the following activities under way:

- All team members are wearing ribbons
- In the Employee Dining Room to create awareness we have Responsible Gaming messages being played on our TVs, table tents with Responsible Gaming information and a 10-foot banner announcing Responsible Gaming Education Week
- Two poster-sized letters from Keith Smith, CEO of Boyd Gaming, prominently displayed in the back of the house that emphasize the importance of responsible gaming
- On Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> we will have sheet cakes in the EDR with the “Get to Know Responsible Gaming” logo
- The Mayor of Mulvane issued a proclamation to declare August 3-7 as Responsible Gaming Education Week in the City of Mulvane, KS.

### Daily Application

While all departments and team members are actively involved in preventing underage, intoxicated and self-excluded patrons from entering the casino floor and from gambling if they do gain access, the Security Officers stationed at the gated entrances are the primary method of prevention. They follow the property’s policy of checking IDs for people who appear 30 or younger; the statistics for these ID checks for the first half of 2015 are:

- Underage individuals denied gaming floor access 372
- People denied access for not having ID 564
- People denied access for invalid ID 892
- Intoxicated individuals denied gaming floor access 187
- VEPs denied access to the gaming floor 8

Further, there were 445 intoxicated individuals ejected from the casino, 13 VEPs were removed and turned over to the KRGC and the Mulvane Police Department; 16 underage persons were caught and ejected from the casino. Also, 223 persons were removed from the casino for a variety of reasons.

During the first half of 2015 we had 1,433,543 guests enter the casino floor. Security team members checked 149,356 IDs and 19 ID checks took place on the gaming floor in situations involving suspected minors.

Several other ongoing efforts are noteworthy. The Kansas Star Casino is an active member and participant in the Kansas Coalition on Problem Gambling and the South Central Task Force on Problem Gambling. We attended the annual Midwest Conference on Problem Gambling and Substance Abuse. And, KSC helped to establish a diversion program in Mulvane City Court for VEPs who are arrested for trespassing. The program allows VEPs to avoid prosecution by entering into treatment with a Kansas Certified Gambling Counselor. The program started in the first half of 2015 and was developed along with State of Kansas problem gambling program managers along with the support of the city court judge, prosecutor and probation officer.

WHEREAS, the overwhelming majority of casino customers enjoy gaming for its entertainment and recreational value and do so responsibly by budgeting their time and money; and




WHEREAS, the Kansas Star Casino devotes significant resources to continuous employee education and awareness including training on responsible gaming and responsible alcohol beverage service; and

Total Gaming Revenue for July 2015 was \$12.5M which was an increase of \$1.5M or 13.5% over July of last year.

Slot Revenue was \$10.8M which was \$1.45M or 15.5% higher than the prior year.

Table Games Revenue was \$1.7M, which was an increase of \$32K or 2.0% compared to prior year.

Our visitation also saw a positive trend, with attendance up 5,000 or 3.0% over July of 2014.

We had our normal complement of monthly promotional offers and restaurant specials in the month of July. During the month, Table Games players earned extra entries for our Table Games Triathlon Tournament, which was held on August, 9<sup>th</sup>.

**Hollywood Casino at Kansas Speedway**  
Responsible Gambling Plan Semi-Annual Report  
January 1, 2015 thru June 30, 2015

**1. Employees**

At the end of the reporting period, Hollywood Casino had a total of 697 employees. During the reporting period, 141 employees were hired.

**2. Responsible Gaming Training:**

All employees hired during the reporting period (141) received initial training on responsible gaming during property orientation. This consisted of approximately 30 minutes dedicated to responsible gaming. All 141 employees successfully completed this training.

Of those new hires, 42 were hired into positions which require additional training to understand the proper procedures for responsible alcohol service. All except three of these employees successfully completed the TiPS training. The three employees that did not successfully pass did so on their second attempt.

In addition, there were 67 existing employees who attended and successfully completed refresher TiPS training.

The TiPS training which was conducted by one of the six certified TiPS trainers on property.

**3. Statistics:**

To assist in tracking the success of the Responsible Gaming Plan, Hollywood Casino maintains statistics related to responsible gaming. Some of the numbers from the reporting period include:

- Hollywood Casino refused entry to 285 minors who attempted to gain access to the property.
- In addition, Hollywood Casino either refused entry to or removed from the property 326 individuals who appeared to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- In addition to training officers to be observant at the casino entrances, Hollywood Casino has procedures in place to identify VEPs when they attempt to cash a check, perform a cash advance, attempt to claim a taxable jackpot, or attempt to create a Marquee Rewards (player club) account. During the reporting period, Hollywood Casino discovered nine (9) VEPs on property. The local KRGC Agent on Duty was contacted immediately in each of these instances and took custody of the VEP for processing.

**AGENDA ITEM:** Procedure for Approving Casino Publications

**PRESENTER:** Don Brownlee

### **ISSUE SUMMARY:**

Since the opening of the Lottery owned casinos in Kansas, Lottery employees and Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission (KRG) employees have reviewed all advertising and promotions the casinos propose prior to publication. Although the Lottery will continue to review these promotions, KRG staff is recommending KRG discontinues the requirement for the casinos to submit promotional and advertising to us for approval prior to their implementation.

In the past KRG's role has been to make sure the advertising materials displayed the Lottery ownership and provided the responsible gambling tag line information. There have not been any issues with the inclusion of the required statements in the last couple of years. Regulations will continue to require the information be included in the advertising material. Staff proposes any omission be dealt with as a regulatory violation thereby eliminating the need for casinos to have their material pre-approved by KRG.

The enabling statute is listed below:

***74-8752: Inspection; investigation; approval of advertising; annual audits; open records exception.***

*(b) In addition to any other powers granted pursuant to this act, the executive director of the racing and gaming commission shall have the power to:*

*(4) inspect and approve, prior to publication or distribution, all advertising by a lottery gaming facility manager or racetrack gaming facility manager which includes any reference to the Kansas lottery;*

The statute provides KRG with the authority to inspect and approve the publications, but does not require it. KRG staff feels the pre-approval is an unnecessary burden on the casinos.

**COMMISSION ACTION REQUIRED/REQUESTED:** Commission discussion, consideration and possible action to approve the change.







