WAGERING AND DEBT
SETOFF
(E.1.d.)

Matthew Bergman, Attorney for Boot Hill Casino, Kansas Star Casino, and Kansas Crossing Casino, reported the position of those casinos on legislation for sports wagering in Kansas and the casinos' upcoming participation in the Kansas Debt Setoff Program:

- There is no current timeframe for the casinos implementing the new debt setoff program. The Department of Administration is beginning to revise their user manuals to comply with the new law, and have presented the casinos with a draft of the user manual.
- On May 14th, the United States Supreme Court held that the Professional and Amateur Sports Protection Act (PASPA), prohibiting most state and local governments from operating, promoting or licensing sports wagering, violated the Constitution's anticommandeering principle and was, therefore, unconstitutional. There were several sports wagering bills presented in the last Kansas legislative session, but none moved out of committee. One interim day of study for sports wagering has been approved by the Kansas Legislature. This day has not yet been calendared. Last year, the casinos supported House Bill 2793 and would likely support similar legislation in the upcoming session.

ISSUE SUMMARY: Pursuant to K.A.R. 112-114-1 *et seq.*, the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission's Disciplinary Review Board (DRB) considered potential gaming regulation violations by licensee Megan Amelia Young. A Summary Proceeding Order and Notice of Hearing and Right to Waive was issued.

2018-3004 Megan Amelia Young

On October 22, 2017, Megan Amelia Young, a security supervisor, was on duty at Hollywood Casino at Kansas Speedway. During Ms. Young's shift, three patrons were determined to be intoxicated and escorted out of the casino. One of the patrons reentered the casino and a surveillance agent notified security personnel that one of the intoxicated patrons had reentered and was gambling at an EGM. Ms. Young approached the intoxicated patron but allowed the intoxicated patron to remain in the casino. The intoxicated patron was later approached by a security supervisor and food and beverage supervisor, was again determined to be intoxicated, and was escorted out of the casino. After reentering the casino, the intoxicated patron gambled at an EGM for approximately 26 minutes. Ms. Young was ordered to serve a two-day suspension. Ms. Young has stipulated to the above facts and waived the right to a hearing. See attached Summary Proceeding Order and Hearing Waiver.

COMMISSION ACTION REQUIRED/REQUESTED: Accept the Hearing Waiver filed by Megan Young and uphold the DRB's Summary Proceeding Order issued in KRGC Case No. 2018-3004.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS: Staff recommends the Commission accept the Hearing Waiver filed by Megan Young and uphold the DRB's findings of fact, conclusions of law, and sanction issued in KRGC Case No. 2018-3004.

**SUMMARY PROCEEDING ORDER AND
NOTICE OF HEARING AND RIGHT TO WAIVE**

The Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission (KRGC), through its Disciplinary Review Board (DRB), hereby gives notice that Megan Amelia Young (Respondent), a security supervisor, has violated KRGC regulations K.A.R. 112-105-1(a)(4), (a)(12)(G); Hollywood Casino Internal Control Chpt: K Security §2.02(E); the Hollywood Casino Security Plan Sect. 2 pg 5; the Hollywood Casino Responsible Gambling Plan pg 1, 2, 5; and the Hollywood Casino Responsible Gaming Security Refresher Training by allowing an intoxicated patron to gamble after being notified of the patron's intoxication:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On June 12, 2015, Respondent received a temporary occupation permit for a position as a security officer from the KRGC. Respondent received a permanent level II gaming license on September 14, 2015, which is currently in active status. Respondent became a security supervisor on February 5, 2016.
2. On October 22, 2017, Respondent was on duty as a security supervisor at Hollywood Casino.
3. At approximately 10:50 p.m., three patrons at a table game were determined to be intoxicated by a security supervisor and a food and beverage supervisor. The three patrons were asked to leave and escorted out of the casino. Two of the three

patrons then left casino property. One of the intoxicated patrons did not leave casino property and reentered the casino.

4. At approximately 11:10 p.m., a surveillance agent notified security personnel via radio that the impaired patron had reentered the casino and was gambling at an electronic gaming machine (EGM).
5. Respondent approached and spoke to the intoxicated patron for approximately ninety seconds. Respondent then told surveillance that she was allowing the patron to stay in the casino.
6. Approximately twenty minutes later, a KRGC agent approached and spoke with the intoxicated patron. The KRGC agent observed that the patron's speech was slurred and that his eyes were red and watery.
7. The security supervisor and food and beverage supervisor who had originally determined that the patron was intoxicated again approached the patron and determined he was still intoxicated. The intoxicated patron was escorted out of the casino. After the patron left the casino, the patron wandered out to an open field near the casino and urinated.
8. After reentering the casino, the intoxicated patron gambled at an EGM for approximately 26 minutes.
9. KRGC regulation K.A.R. 112-105-1(a) requires that: "[the] security department shall do the following: . . . (4) assist with the enforcement of all applicable laws and regulations; . . . (12) establish and maintain procedures for handling the following: . . . (G) alcoholic beverage control[.]"
10. Pursuant to K.A.R. 112-105-1(a)(12)(G), Hollywood Casino implemented

Hollywood Casino Internal Control Chpt: K Security §2.02(E) which states:

“Security Officers [will] monitor for intoxicated persons attempting to enter the casino. Intoxicated persons will not be allowed to engage in gaming activities in the casino. . . .”

11. The Hollywood Casino Security Plan Sect 2, pg 5 requires the following:
 - a. “The Security Officer serves as the most fundamental extension of management. Each Security Officer is responsible for monitoring all activity in the casino, as well as their immediate surroundings[; and]
 - b. Specific responsibilities [include to] be on constant vigil for . . . unruly or intoxicated persons. . . .”

12. The Hollywood Casino Responsible Gambling Plan pg 1, 2, 5 requires the following:
 - a. “Hollywood Casino will: . . . 9. Prevent gambling by intoxicated patrons[;]
 - b. Hollywood Casino will educate all employees regarding . . . the prohibition of gambling by intoxicated patrons. . . . Appropriate employees . . . will be trained in a TiPS Program. TiPS gives individuals the knowledge and confidence they need to recognize potential alcohol-related problems and intervene to prevent alcohol-related incidents. . . . The training program includes: . . . 6. Procedures designed to prevent persons from gaming after having been determined to be visibly intoxicated.”

13. Hollywood Casino’s Responsible Gaming Security Refresher Training requires the following:

- a. “Hollywood is prohibited from allowing an impaired guest to stay on [the] gaming floor[;]
 - b. Look for the following signs of impairment: slurred speech, loss of coordination, bloodshot eyes, strong smell of alcohol, [and] inappropriate behavior[;]
 - c. Security has three goals when handling a 55 [impaired patron]:
 - [1.] Stop the guest’s gaming and drinking
 - [2.] Escort the guest out of the casino safely
 - [3.] Ensure that the guest leaves property safely[.]”
14. K.A.R. 112-113-1(a) states that “any licensee may be sanctioned for violating any provision of the . . . [KRG] regulations . . . including . . . [for] (5) failing to follow . . . the facility manager’s minimum internal control system; (6) failing to follow the commission’s security regulations or the facility manager’s security plan; [and] (9) failing to enforce the facility manager’s responsible gaming plan or the provisions of article 112. . . .”

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

15. Under K.A.R. 112-105-1(a)(4) & (a)(12)(G), Hollywood Casino Internal Control Chpt: K Security §2.02(E), the Hollywood Casino Security Plan Sect 2, pg 5, the Hollywood Casino Responsible Gambling Plan pg 1, 2, 5, and Hollywood Casino’s Responsible Gaming Security Refresher Training, Respondent had a duty to remove the intoxicated patron from the gaming floor and prohibit him from gambling.
16. Respondent violated K.A.R. 112-105-1(a)(4) & (a)(12)(G), Hollywood Casino

Internal Control Chpt: K Security §2.02(E), the Hollywood Casino Security Plan Sect 2, pg 5, the Hollywood Casino Responsible Gambling Plan pg 1, 2, 5, and Hollywood Casino's Responsible Gaming Security Refresher Training when Respondent allowed the intoxicated patron to remain on the gaming floor and gamble at an EGM for 26 minutes.

17. Because Respondent had been notified that the patron had already been determined to be intoxicated, Respondent knew she was allowing an intoxicated patron to remain on the gaming floor and gamble in violation of KRGC regulations and Hollywood Casino policies.
18. By enabling an intoxicated patron to gamble, Respondent's actions compromised the integrity of gaming in Kansas and put the safety of the gaming environment at risk.

STATEMENT OF POLICY

Under the Kansas Expanded Lottery Act, the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission is required to oversee the enforcement of state laws, enforcement of internal controls, and the credentialing of employees at Kansas lottery gaming facilities. The Kansas Expanded Lottery Act directed the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission to adopt rules and regulations to oversee all lottery gaming facility operations. Pursuant to this mandate, the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission created regulations that subject a licensee to sanctions, including license suspension or revocation, when the licensee violates any provision of KRGC regulations, a facility manager's internal controls, a facility manager's responsible gambling plan, or a facility manager's security plan.

By requiring licensees to adhere to KRGC regulations, the facility manager's internal

controls, the facility manager's responsible gambling plan, and the facility manager's security plan the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission ensures the safety of gaming facilities and integrity of gaming in Kansas. The regulations, internal controls, responsible gambling plan, and security plan provisions regarding procedures for preventing intoxicated patrons from gambling are integral to protecting the integrity and safety of the gaming environment. Intoxicated patrons are in a compromised state of mind and unable to make clear-headed decisions. Gambling while in that compromised state poses a risk to themselves and others. When security supervisors fail to ensure that intoxicated patrons are prevented from gambling by escorting them off the gaming floor, security officers under their supervision will perceive that allowing intoxicated patrons to remain on the gaming floor is acceptable. Enforcement of these provisions is necessary to protect the safety of gaming facilities and integrity of gaming in the state of Kansas.

SANCTION

19. In accordance with K.A.R. 112-113-1(c), the DRB may consider certain factors in considering appropriate sanctions, including risk to the public and to the integrity of gaming operations created by the conduct of the licensee; the nature of the violation; culpability of the licensee; any justification or excuse for the conduct; the licensee's history with respect to compliance; and corrective action taken by the licensee. Moreover, K.A.R. 112-113-1(e) states "it shall be no absolute defense that the licensee . . . inadvertently, unintentionally, or unknowingly" committed a regulatory violation and "shall affect only the degree of the sanction to be imposed. . . ."
20. The DRB considers the following factors:
 - a. Respondent had been employed as a security supervisor for approximately

one year and eight months at the time of this. Before being promoted to security supervisor, Respondent was employed as security officer for approximately eight months.

- b. As a security supervisor, Respondent is under the heightened expectation to model security procedures strictly and diligently for subordinates. Respondent allowed an intoxicated patron to gamble after being notified that the patron had already been determined to be intoxicated.
 - c. There is no justification or excuse for the conduct. Respondent was notified that the patron had already been determined to be intoxicated and escorted out of the casino due to his intoxication. Shortly after interacting with the Respondent, the patron continued to show visible signs of intoxication.
 - d. Respondent is directly culpable for these violations. Respondent knowingly allowed the patron to remain on the gaming floor and gamble at an EGM while intoxicated.
 - e. Respondent took no corrective action. Another security supervisor and food and beverage supervisor had to approach and ask the intoxicated patron to leave a second time after Respondent interacted with the intoxicated patron.
 - f. Respondent has no history of regulatory violations.
21. Based on the above-described findings of fact, conclusions of law, statement of policy, and sanction factors the DRB orders the Respondent to serve a two-day unpaid suspension. The two-day suspension shall total 16 hours. The dates of the

two-day unpaid suspension shall be determined by the KRGC supervising enforcement agent for the gaming facility where Respondent is employed.

22. Respondent is entitled to a hearing on the above matter, which Respondent may waive by signing and returning the enclosed Hearing Waiver to the KRGC by mail, email, or fax. (See Notice of Hearing and Right to Waive below.)
23. If Respondent waives the right to a hearing, the two-day unpaid suspension must be served within 30 days of this Order becoming final and effective. This Order becomes final and effective on August 17, 2018.
24. Once the suspension is served, Respondent must send a timesheet showing the suspension occurred to the KRGC by mail, email, or fax to the address listed below within 30 days of this Order becoming final and effective.
25. If Respondent does not serve the ordered two-day unpaid suspension or does not send a timesheet showing the suspension occurred within 30 days of this Order becoming final and effective, Respondent's license will be automatically indefinitely suspended at the end of the business day without further notification or action taken by the Commission until all terms of this Order are fulfilled and the Respondent's license is reinstated by the KRGC.
26. This Order shall become part of Respondent's permanent KRGC licensing file.

ORDER

In accordance with the above-described findings of fact, conclusions of law, statement of policy, and sanction factors,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission suspend Respondent's license for two days.

Hearing - Presentation of Written Evidence:

Unless Respondent waives the right to a hearing, this matter will be presented to the Commission on **Friday August 17, 2018 at 9:00 am** at the Eisenhower State Office Building, 700 SW Harrison, Suite 410, Topeka, KS 66603.

Written evidence will be presented along with brief oral arguments by the agency and Respondent. Surveillance video may also be presented. Neither party will present live witness testimony at this time. Respondent has the right to be represented by counsel at the Respondent's expense.

If Respondent does not appear at the hearing, a decision will be made on the evidence presented, and any decision will become final agency action. If Respondent has written evidence to present to the Commission, copies of all relevant written evidence must be sent (by mail, email, or fax) no later than August 3, 2017 to the address below.

Following arguments, the Commission will consider the arguments and evidence presented, and if the Commission determines no further evidence is necessary for a finding, the Commission will issue its Order. The Commission can uphold, overturn, or amend the Disciplinary Review Board's Summary Order. If the Commission determines further evidence is necessary for a finding, the case will be continued to the next commission meeting to allow for a full evidentiary hearing. If the Commission issues an Order without a full evidentiary hearing, the Respondent has an automatic right to a full evidentiary hearing where witness testimony will be taken. The right to a full evidentiary hearing may be waived by Respondent prior to the scheduled hearing (see Waiving Right to a Hearing below).

Full Evidentiary Hearing – Presentation of Witness Testimony:

The full evidentiary hearing with witnesses, if required, will be held at the regularly scheduled Commission meeting on Friday September 14, 2018 at 10:00 am at the Eisenhower State Office Building, 700 SW Harrison, Suite 410, Topeka, KS 66603. (Date and location subject to change).

At this hearing, Respondent has the right to produce additional evidence and witnesses on the Respondent's behalf, the right to cross-examine any witness who may testify against the Respondent, and the right to examine any evidence that may be produced against the Respondent.

The Commission will issue a final Order either directly after deliberation or within 30 days of the hearing date. This Order will constitute final agency action and is subject to appeal under the Kansas Judicial Review Act. If Respondent does not appear at the hearing in person or

by phone, a decision will be made on the evidence presented, and any decision will become final agency action subject to appeal under the Kansas Judicial Review Act. The agency officer to receive service of any petition for judicial review on behalf of the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission is Judith Taylor, General Counsel, at the address below. Any sanction imposed by the Order may be stayed pending appeal.

Respondent shall submit any additional exhibits and a witness list no later than August 31, 2018 to Judith Taylor, General Counsel, at the address below.

If a full evidentiary hearing is held, the hearing will be conducted in accordance with KRGC regulations. If allowed to appear by phone, KRGC will *not* be responsible for sound quality issues that arise from Respondent's use of a cell phone, voice-over-internet (VOIP) connection, or other non-landline phone connection. Sound quality issues could affect the Commission's ability to understand Respondent's testimony, thus every effort to appear in person should be made.
