Chairman Jay Shadwick called the February 15, 2013, meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. at the City of Mulvane City Council Chambers, 211 North Second Avenue, Mulvane, KS. In addition to Chairman Shadwick, Commissioners Dennis McKinney, Timothy A. Shultz, R. Eileen King and David H. Moses were present at the meeting. Others present included Executive Director Richard Petersen-Klein, Director of Security Don Brownlee, Interim Director of Administration and Finance Brandi White, General Counsel Judith Taylor, recording secretary Chris Vega and other staff.

Bob Sheldon, General Manager, reported that:

- Total gaming revenue for January was \$10.2 million, a decrease of 6.8% from December.
- Slot revenue for January was \$8.2 million, a decrease of 6.9% from December.
- Table games revenue was \$1.9 million, a decrease of 6.2% from December
- Total visitors declined by 8.7% compared to December.

HILL CASINO & RESORT:

Diane Giardine, Director of Human Resources, presenting on behalf of Sharon Stroburg, reported that:

- January came in approximately 17% under last year's revenue and 4.5% under last month (December).
- Revenue was impacted due to 6 inches of snow on December 31, 2012, as snow removal for the roads in the surrounding areas took several days.

- The breezeway connecting the casino to the arena will be opening soon to allow admittance for both conferences and events.

Scott Cooper, General Manager, reported that:

- January admissions per day are 13% higher than the previous 20 week average in 2012.
- As of December 31, 2012, Kansas Star Casino had 896 team members on payroll.
- 90% of team members are new to gaming.
- Construction work continues on the arena conversion.
- Gaming Revenues:
 - Slot coin-in flat from January 2012
 - Slot win up 1.6% from January 2012
 - Slot hold up slightly from January 2012
 - Table game drop down 9% from January 2012
 - Table game win up 42% from January 2012
 - Table game hold 21.4% vs. 13.7% last January
 - Poker room average daily revenue down 6% from December 2012

Chairman Shadwick called for public comments. Four members of the public spoke about various topics in support of problem gambling treatment initiatives.

STAFF REPORTS;

Mr. Petersen-Klein, reported that:

- Voluntary Exclusion Program (VEP) application approvals for January totaled 37, which is the highest number of applicants KRGK has had since the program began.
- Senate Bill 114 and House Bill 2168 are looking to reduce the investment in the Southeast gaming zone for a lottery gaming facility, and adjust the slot machine revenues from racetracks in an effort to resurrect the horse and greyhound racing industries.
- Senate Bill 148 is a bill intended to legalize raffles and poker runs conducted by non-profit charities for fundraising. Senate Bill 148 may be tied to a House resolution for a constitutional amendment allowing charitable raffles and poker runs.
- There are various bills introduced in the Legislature to expand lottery gaming slot machines in various veterans venues.
- House Bill 2293 was recently introduced regarding commissioner salaries.

The report identifies several violations of statutes and regulations, and the resulting action taken.

K. S. A. 79-4715 The director of alcoholic beverage control of the department of revenue shall submit to the Kansas racing and gaming commission semiannual activity reports concerning inspections and investigations of bingo operations in this state.

Game reviews.

- During this period there were fifty-six game reviews and three telephone reviews conducted.

Compliance violations during this time period include:

- K.S.A. 79-4705 (a) On dates prescribed by the administrator every operator shall make a return to the administrator upon forms prescribed by the administrator.
There were twenty-three fines issued to organizations and four fines issued to one distributor for failure to file reports on time.
- K.A.R. 92-23-38 Each licensee shall keep and maintain records that are necessary to determine the amount of tax due and to determine that the games of bingo operated or conducted in compliance with the bingo act.
The organization under review had not kept complete records. A fine was issued.
- K.S.A. 79-4701 (c) The books and records for the preceding four months shall be available without advance notice at all times that the licensee is operating or conducting games of bingo.
Two organizations had not kept their records on site preventing the completion of the audit. Fines were issued to both organizations.
- K.S.A. 79-4703 (3) (d) The licensee shall display the license in a prominent place in the vicinity of the area where it is to conduct bingo.
Three organizations had not renewed on time. Fines were issued.

- K.A.R. 92-23-14 (b) Whenever a licensee intends to conduct bingo games on a date or at a time different from that previously furnished in writing to the secretary of revenue, the licensee shall submit written notice of the change to the bingo enforcement unity of the department of revenue at least seven days prior to the effective date of that change.
Four organizations changed their playing schedules and failed to notify charitable gaming. Fines were issued.

- K.S.A. 79-4706-(p) (2) One drawing during a session may be conducted by the licensee ...No more than four of such drawings shall be conducted by each licensee.
Agent discovered there had been five drawings during the year and a fine was issued.

Warnings:

- a. Late deposits-licensees are required to make deposits within 24 hrs. of the last bingo session.
- b. Revenue from the snack bar had been deposited into the bingo trust account.-only revenue from the sale of bingo faces and instant bingo or pull-tabs are to be deposited into this account.







AGENDA ITEM: Proposed amendment to junket regulations
