- Sharon Stroburg, general manager of the Boot Hill Casino and Resort, reported that:
- April revenues were under budget due to construction disruption; however, for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2012, BHCR was approximately 11% over last year and 2% over budget.
  - The expansion project is progressing. The high limit slots area opened April 30 with an invited guest reception, and the poker room opened on May 1. The additional expansion (216 slots) is projected to open on September 1, 2012.

- Scott Cooper, general manager for the Kansas Star Casino, reported:
- Progress on the second phase of construction is on schedule.
  - To date, the Kansas Star Casino has awarded approximately \$42M in sub-contracts, of which 90% have been to Kansas contractors.
  - April revenues were down from March in slots, table games, and the poker room.

Bob Sheldon, General Manager for the Hollywood Casino at the Kansas Speedway, reported that:

- April revenues were down somewhat from the month of March.
- Approximately 20 new slots have been purchased to replace underperforming slots on the floor.
- The NASCAR Sprint Cup event occurred on the weekend of April 20. While revenues were not as great as anticipated, the experience gained will assist in improving traffic flow and other considerations during and after major race events in the future.

On April 27, KRGC issued a notice to all Kansas horse breeding and racing organizations and individual horse owners announcing that it would take written and oral testimony at the May 11 meeting concerning whether to amend the rules and regulations related to the registration of horses under the Kansas-bred program authorized by K.S.A. 74-8830. Interested parties were invited to provide testimony on the pros and cons of implementing a procedure to defer registration of horses under the Kansas-bred program until such time as parimutuel racing is re-established in the State of Kansas, in lieu of the present active registering of horses with no guarantee of future benefit.
