GOVERNOR GRANTS EXTENSIONS FOR LOTTERY GAMING FACILITY REVIEW BOARD

Topeka - Kansas Governor Kathleen Sebelius today granted the Lottery Gaming Facility Review Board 60-day extensions in all four gaming zones to complete its work. The governor made the extension under authority granted to her by KSA 74-8736(f). The Review Board voted at its June 3 meeting to request that extensions be granted for each gaming zone. These extensions will move the deadlines for final decisions on management agreements to the following:

Cherokee County- September 5, 2008
Ford County- September 26, 2008
Sumner County- September 26, 2008
Wyandotte County- September 26, 2008

The Review Board previously announced its schedule to hold hearings in each gaming zone. The board is currently scheduled to make its decisions for Cherokee and Sumner County on August 21-22 and on September 18-19 for Ford and Wyandotte.
